Agreeable to an order of the Worshipful County Court of Montgomery County to us Directed Dated November Court 1802, after being duly sworn we attended on the plantation of Wm Robinson deceased and laid off as the share

of Maryann Robinson one third of 354 acres of Land including of the mansion house, where the deceased Wm Robinson formerly lived which is bounded as follows Beginning at a Sugar tree near the spring northward of the said mansion house and extending South 140 poles to the line of a 500 acre survey part of Wm Grumbles purchase. Thence West with said line 164 poles to a small red oak in a hollow in Heart line. Thence North with said line 140 poles.

Thence East 164 poles to the Beginning — which we allot to her as her one third part of the land. Also one half of the profits of a
