do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and
disannul all and every other former Testa-
ments wills, and legacies, bequests and
Executors by me in anywise before now
willed or bequeathed. Ratifying and Confirming
this and no other to be my last will
and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
nineteenth day of August in the year
of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
and One. Signed sealed published pronoun-
ced and declared by the said David England
as his last will and Testament in
the presence of us who in his presence -
