tract of land containing three hundred
acres lying on the head of Davis's fork
near of Bird's Creek for which a little
bond was taken from Thomas
to hold to her the said Rachel for her life
if she survive and also I give and bequeath
to my said daughter Rachel one room
house which is now in the premises
secondly I give and bequeath unto
my daughter Jane, Ruth, Mary, and
Susan each five shillings a piece.
And I give and bequeath to my sons
John, Stephen, Robert, & Charles
five shillings each. And lastly I do
hereby appoint Richard Bird as
executor of the my last will and

ment hereby revoking all former wills
by me made. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the ninth
day of February in the year of our
lord one thousand eight hundred and
signed sealed ^{published} Robert Hall
delivered by the above named Robert
Hall to be his last will and testament
in the presence of us who have hereunto
subscribed names, as Witnesses, in the
presence of the testator.
