 In the name of God amen, To all
 to whom it may concern, Know ye that
 I William Hart of Montgomery County
 in a State of Kentucky being at present
 confined to my bed of affliction and per-
 fectly sound in mind and knowing the
 uncertainty of this mortal life and the
 certainty of death do make and ordain
 this as my last will and Testament in
 manner herein as followeth To wit

first I give to my Dearly Beloved
 wife the whole of my Estate untill my
 youngest Child shall arrive to the age
 of Eighteen years then the thirds of it
 to be equally Divided among all my
 Children to the then and their Heir
 forever, and provided she shall marry
 before the youngest Child shall be
 Eighteen years of age then shall
 my Estate be Divided in three
 Equal parts One part I give to
 my wife during life and the other
 two equally divided among all
 my Children and at the death of
 my wife the third part to be
 Equally Divided among all my
 Children, Secondly I will that my
 negro man Peter by name shall
 serve for the use of my Estate five
 years after two hundred Dollars to
 the Estate and then he shall be
 free and all the rest of my Slaves
 by name Alice, Lucy, Anna, Selma
 and Turner shall be Emancipated
 with their Children if they should
 have

have any as soon as they lawfully arrive
 at thirty years of age except the last mentioned
 by name Turner who shall serve until he is twenty one year of age and then
 be free, Thirdly I do nominate and
 appoint my friend Joseph Trank and my
 wife Nancy Hart as Executors To this my
 Last will and Testament I have my
 hand the 14th day of June one thousand
 Eight hundred and three.
