Lane - That all my estate (after
the payment of my just debts real
and Personal & mixed be appor-
tioned to the use and benefit
of my beloved wife and Children
entirely at the discretion of my wife
during her life or widowed hood
Subject to the following vestments
I give & bequeath unto my eldest
son Henry Smith Lane the hundred
acres of land to include the improve-
ments called Parakerigan place
in Montgomery County to be given
up to my ^{said} son Henry at the death
or marriage of his mother or at any
time before, that his mother may
think proper I give & bequeath
all the remainder of my land
estate to be equally divided

the remainder of my Children (except
my Henry) Subject to my sole control & con-
above described I desire that the whole
of my estate (Lands excepted) be equally
divided among all my child and by my
beloved wife Letty Lane. It is my will
& desire that my beloved wife Letty
Lane act as executrix my son Henry
Lane & my son Benjamin Thompson
as Executors to this my will thereby giv-
ing them and each of them as Qualify-
ing themselves to leave the Survivors Sur-
vivors of them ample full and ample
power to buy sell or exchange real
and personal property & when so
sold or exchanged conveyances & dis-
charges to make, give, receive & to do
all other things which may to them seem
best for the interest of the estate -
