We the undersigned Commissioners met together at the house of Jane Bentley widow of Arthur Bentley deceased all the heirs and representatives of said deceased being present also the widow in Court we proceeded as Commissioners to make a division of the estate all the heirs and representatives concerning thereof after settling some difficulties among themselves concerning the division by signing an article of agreement also at the request of the widow and after the said all the heirs appeared we allotted the widow her dower in the slaves and personal estate which had not been done before then in a do out our report and do report as follows
