In the name of God Amen being of sound perfect mind & memory but conscious of the uncertainty of this mortal life. I do hereby make my last will and Testament in the manner and form following. After my debts my wife and child is that all my estate both real and personal shall be equally divided amongst all my children that are living. My wife is to have one third of all my estate both real and personal after all my just debts are paid. And one hundred dollars. I do give and bequeath unto Peggy Myer my daughter who to which daughter is deceased and the balance after all my just debts are paid and one hundred dollars to Peggy Myer is to be equally divided amongst my children. My wife is to have her share in the sum of \$1000 I have her and let my hand and seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1820
