 law in pursuance of said Commission proceed to take
 the negroes & negroes of said district
 by the report of the Commissioners appointed by the Maryland
 County Court in the State of Virginia where the lands of said
 District lies (which is herewith reported, together with the
 the said Districts Act of Land and Negroes before our Court
 to Elizabeth Daniel late Elizabeth White we have allotted one
 Negro Girl named Nancy of us valued to three hundred and
 thirty Dollars which we have balance of said Act coming
 to her to make her share equal to the other negroes of
 said District viz viz to her three cents, to be paid out of
 the moneys allotted to the said District these sons
 to take care of any such one Negro girl named Nancy
