In the House of Reps. Aaron J. John Solomon of the County of
Montgomery and State of Kentucky being in an affected
state of body but perfectly sound in mind and memory
the sanity of all his mental things do make affidavit and
advise that he by last will and Testament has bequeathed
and given as follows, to wit
I do give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Phoebe Solomon one third
part of all my Estate both real and personal during her natural
life and let her death to be disposed as shall be hereafter mentioned
together with all my personal property of her own and used for the use
of her own family
I do give and bequeath to the children of my Daughter Sally Mayson
that is to say three fourths of her body two hundred Dollars and to the
children I have and my Daughter Rachel Solomon two hundred
Dollars and to the children born of my Daughter Hanna Hambrick
two hundred Dollars all of which to be put into the hands of my
wife Phoebe and my son John Solomon and by them to be equally
divided among the children of my said Daughter when they
shall have all come of age or at any time they may demand it
and take receipt
I do give and bequeath to my Daughter-in-law Sally Solomon
and one of my son Joseph Solomon one hundred Dollars
I do give and bequeath to my son John Solomon and to the
rest of my children that is to say John Solomon Nath Solomon
William Solomon James Solomon Raphael Solomon and
Solomon Phoebe John Solomon is a Solomon Lucinda Solomon
and Mary Solomon are the rest of my children and
personal to be equally divided among them when they
shall have all come to the age of 21 years or when they
or the following manner when any of them who now
are or may hereafter arrive at the age of 21 years or the all
among them my Executors my Executors shall call on these
disinterested men to estimate the value of my Estate
and apportion to them their portion by dividing my slaves into
as many lots as equal as possible as there are children
left named and have the money of the Slave or Slaves with
their portion of my Estate come next to they shall pay the
one third of the balance of my Estate for the benefit of my
Estate but if the lot of Slaves to draw shall not be
equal to the proportion each child is entitled to receive, it
shall be made up to them in money
I do give and bequeath to my last named children after
the death of my wife the whole of my Estate which may

to be equally divided among them
I do give and bequeath to my son William Solomon one
hundred Dollars and an iron bar with which he is now
in possession of and to my son James Solomon one
hundred dollars which is now in possession of, and to
Raphael Solomon one hundred dollars and one by and
which he is now in possession of
I do lastly I do hereby appoint my Beloved wife Phoebe
Solomon and my son John Solomon Executors to this
my last will and Testament which I have made
and signed this 21 day of January 1822 John Solomon

 County of Montgomery and State of Kentucky being
 well in body but bowed in mind do make this
 my last will and Testament thus I will to assign
 my land to him that first gave it whereon he may think
 proper to come on it then the 6th South my cattle & own
 things & the children furniture and farming utensils to be
 his & if my best little son I should think to be
 sufficient to buy my two slaves to be his for the best price
 which he can be had for them till my debt be paid
 then to give my debt is paid I give my negro slave
 Lucia during her life time then to 5th & 6th I direct
 that my wife Maria Charlotte before whom she arrived at
 the age of being one year then 6th South has to have her
 portion viz the one year from under my hand and seal
 this being the day of Myra thousand eight hundred and
 twenty four
