We the undersigned Commissioners agreeable to an order of the Montgomery County Court first being duly sworn Met at the house of Margaret Davis on the first of March 1816 and then proceeded to allot to the said Margaret the Widow of Nathaniel Davis her dower and to divide the estate of said decedent among the heirs and find the appraisement of slaves hereditarily what Polly Igo late Polly Davis has claimed to amount to \$7000 the personal estate with Bonds due to the estate to amount to \$1268. 16 cents we then proceeded to allot to the said Widow her dower and to divide the balance of said estate between the heirs of said decedent. Polly Igo being in the manner following (to wit)

My share part of the following Slaves named

 Scott a Negro Boy 300
 her part of Slaves \$75 due Much which was taken from her part of the said bonds and is to be paid to the heirs part
