 personal & real which I wish to be sold by my executors to be used
 after named and returned in his hands on by as the heirs of me
 her proper person shall require it to be the said debt and not to be paid
 to her husband or any other person but her I do hereby appoint
 my friend Isaac Harrow as my Executor to this my last will & Testament
 hereby revoking & annulling any former will I may heretofore have
 made declaring and establishing this as I for my last will & Testament
 In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and this 28th day
 of January 1817

At a Court held for Montgomery County on the 6th day of Janu-
 ary 1817 This Instrument purporting to be the last
 will & Testament of Rowland H. Gaines deceased was produced
 in Court & proven by the oath of Nelson Payne & Richard Griffin
 & ordered to be recorded & Isaac Harrow the executor therein named
 made oath according to law & gave bond in the penalty of two hundred
 dollars with Menas Harrow & Virgil Garrett his securities
 conditioned according to law therefore a certificate is granted
 him for obtaining a probate in due form & same will be duly granted

 have this 18th day of January 1817 proceeded to divide four negroes
 to wit, Charles, Jeph, Sophy & Charlotte between the parties
 above mentioned & having been duly sworn do declare that
 1 Charlotte in one lot 2 Jeph & Sophy in another lot 3 the
 parties receiving Charles & his wife to pay to Jeph & Sophy \$75
 1 the other having been given to John Garrett by John Har-
 row the guardian & Garrett made a choice of Charles & his wife
 as aforesaid all of which is returned to the Court the date

Under the authority of the County Court of Montgomery by their
order to us the undersigned Commissioners, directed who after his
