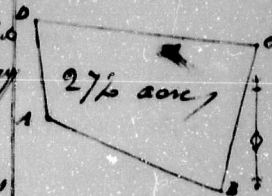

 Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore by me made
 Having done and will that all my just debts be paid
 Then it is my will and desire that as far as I have given
 my property to my children as their portion of my Estate
 remain in their possession without alienation in every case
 and that the balance that remains in my possession be given
 in the following manner to wit:
