I Daniel Giffin of Montgomery County and State of Kentucky being in sound mind and knowing that that I am old and weak make this my last will and testament I give and bequeath my soul to God that gave it and my body to the Lord Jesus Christ and it is my will that all my debts be paid I leave and bequeath my real and personal to my beloved wife Rachel Giffin During her natural life I give and bequeath it is my will that my son Miller Giffin when he comes of age should have one half of the improved Land and one half of the wood Land for to make use of During my wife's life time it is to be understood that my wife is to have the house and land convenient to it and at her death it is my will that he should have all my Land lying on Grassy Creek containing fifty acres to him and his heirs forever and that I leave and bequeath to my son Thomas Giffin two Dollars at my wife's death I will and bequeath to my son John Giffin ten Dollars at the death of my wife and at my wife's death it is my will that my Daughter Nancy and Lucy Giffin should have all the household & kitchen furniture to be equally divided between them and each of them to have one cow apiece It is my will that my wife Rachel be my Executor and that brother A. H. H. be my Executor to this my last will and testament signed and acknowledged in presence of us
