Agreeable to an order of the Montgomery County Court
 pronounced at their May Court 1820 appointing and naming
 as commissioners to settle with Wm Kemper guardian for
 Nancy Rogers did meet at the house of Wm Kemper in
 Montgomery County on the 31st day of Jan'y 1825 and then
 they proceeded to make the settlement in the presence of said
 guardian and a John Perkins who has seen a de date of the order
 intermarried with Nancy Rogers they make several arrange-
 ments for the settlement and proceed to business and ad-
 judged till the 9th day of Feb'y next agreeable to a judgment
 notes received by Wm Kemper as guardian for
 Nancy Rogers paid they the balance of Wm Rogers note
 due the 19th day of Nov 1818 for
 Interest on same until the 19th day of Feb'y 1825 it being
 6 years and three months making this sum 377 29
 Also one note recd as above due the 19th day of Nov 1815 for
 Interest on the same until the 19th day of Feb'y 1825 it
 being 5 years and three months making this sum 98 13
 Also one other note Recd as above due the 19th day
 of Nov 1820 for
 Interest on same until the 19th day of Feb'y 1825 it
 being 4 years and three months making this sum 23 12
 Six per cent is allowed said guardian for his ser-
 vices on \$1796.96 & cts this being the amount of principal
 and interest when all the money was due making
 this sum 106 01
 leaving this amount for the guardian to account for
 due to the guardian per vouchers filed - - - 2079 96
