In the name of God Amen, I, William Ball of Montgomery county & State of Kentucky, being weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, also considering the uncertainty of this mortal life, blessed be the almighty God for the same, do publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Ball all that tract or parcel of land on which I now live, lying and being in the County of Montgomery and Bourbon, State aforesaid, together with all the right of my property residue and remainder, of my personal property, estate goods and chattels of what kind and nature soever during her life, or widowhood, at which time I wish an equal division amongst & with my children. My will is further that my just debts be paid by my heirs &c. herein after named. I do further more appoint my beloved wife (above named, Mary Ball) the sole executrix of this my last will and Testament, and hereby recording all former wills by me made.
