dollars. I Give to my daughter Susannah Dancy i give and be
= queath one dollar. I Give the remainder of my estate whatever it
may be to be Equally divided amongst the rest of my children
admitting Thomas Edmunds son to Susannah Dancy to have equal
legate with the rest of my children. I Give and appoint
and constitute Edmund Edmunds to be the sole executor of this my
last will and testament and as fully and as much as he shall see
other wills legacies or bequests satisfying and confirming this to be
my last will and testament.
