I also unto my said beloved wife two ~~beds~~ beds together with the shelf ware, wood ware and pot mettle, the choice of two cows, and one horse creature with the one she owned when married to me, together with four breeding sows - And also I give unto my sons David and Henry one hundred and eighty acres of land lying on the South side of the above mentioned land to
