Grandson the son of John Harden a Tractor Parcel of
land on Pattersons Creek in Hampshire County in
Virginia One Hundred Acres More or less in the Lot
N^o Seventeenth on the south side of said Creek and
also forty four Acres Adjoining to the other land for
him fully to Enjoy and possess

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Granddaughter
Ratly Thomas two Hundred acres of land near Hardens
Settlement on a Run called or known by the name of the
Cott run a branch of Rough Creek for her fully
to enjoy and possess

the following manner Item First of all I give and bequeath
to my wellbeloved wife Elizabeth whom I also constitute and or-
dain the sole Executor of this my last will and Testament
all and in singular My lands and Messuages and Incomes
to by her to be freely Enjoyed and possessed also my mov-
able Effects and Household furniture also Debts & dues
of every kind and from every person except she the said
Elizabeth my wife should have a child in nine months
after my decease then I will that the said Child should
have the one half of my lands and household furniture
when he or she comes to age And that such child if any
comes shall be carefully Educated by my said Executor
on the interest arising from such child's part Item
I give unto my mother one yearling horse. Item I give
to my beloved Brother and then Children three Horse
creatures a Saddle Rifle Gun and Clothes to be sold and
distributed Equally Among them and to be deliv^{ed}
