

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In the name of God amen I Andrew Hynes of the County of Nelson and State of Kentucky do ordain and declare this instrument of writing to be my first Will and Testament and revoking all others, I imprint all my first debts to be speedily paid which are but few except what I owe in Partnership with William R Hynes which debts are to be paid out of the money arising from the profits of the Store in which they originated and that as soon as the money can possibly be collected. The herein after bequeathed are to be fulfilled as soon as circumstances will permit in manner hereafter directed. Item to my Dearest beloved wife Elizabeth Hynes I give and bequeath all my Personal movable property to wit Slaves Stock of all Kinds of description, Bonds, notes Book accounts, Debts, goods, and Chattels of every description whatever that may or can be considered as personal Estates and moveable property. Also so much of my Land Estate which I now have also my plantation as hereafter mentioned to wit the plantation lying at the Junction of the Branch fork and Rolling Fork of Salt River - Also one acre of land lying in Hardin County on the South side of the Rolling fork, and opposite the last mentioned plantation. Also a plantation Town lying in Lovers Valley Hardin County. Also my house & lot in Bairntown. The

whole of the before mentioned property (except the plantation at the Junction of the Branch & Rolling fork the acre of land on the south side of the Rolling fork of pasture the said plantation my house and lot in Bairntown to continue in my wife Elizabeth Hynes possession for the support of my family, and education of my Children so long as she continues my widow. But in case she should alter her situation by marriage then if in that case she is to have what the law allows. The property above excepted to wit the plantation acre of land and the House & lot is also to continue in her possession as above until my son Abner Hynes twenty one years of age, then to descend to my son Abner with other property as is hereafter directed. I also direct that all the lots in Elizabeth Town Hardin County which were purchased for my benefit but not yet conveyed shall be sold and the money arising from the sales of said lots to be applied as before directed to the Education of my Children and Support of my family. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Hynes & my Daughter Nancy Hynes Jointly all the land of one hundred of an acre in Lovers Valley Hardin County which lands contain about six hundred acres to the same as aforesaid to be equally divided between them when both become of age to be equally divided by two

disinterested persons chosen by themselves provided
they cannot agree on the division themselves —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Abner Hynes
the Plantation I own at the mouth of the Beach and
Rolling fork containing four hundred and eighteen
acres of land and known by the name of Kennedy's
Station — I also give to my son Abner Hynes one
acre of land with the appurtenances thereunto
belonging lying on the south side of the Rolling fork
and opposite the mouth of the Beach fork and now
in the possession of Duke Calvin — also fifty acres of land

daughter Nancy Hynes of Polly Hynes each one

hundred pounds Cash to be raised out of lands that are in the hands of my Executors the money to be paid to them so soon as they enter into the state of Illinois among Item being desirous that the Salem Academy should be encouraged and the present building for that purpose completed I beseeche to give unto the trustees of said Academy five hundred acres of land lying in Hardin County on the Waters of Clifty and being the one half of a thousand acre Survey in the name of Hynes Ferry on the following conditions (to will that provided the trustees of said Academy cause the walls of the present building to be completely covered) if covered within twelve months from this date that then the above four hundred acres of land to be appropriated by the said Trustees towards the finishing the inside work in such way as shall be deemed most beneficial & advantageous - and it is my intention to give my right title of interest only and that neither me nor my heirs to be accountable or liable to make good the land or any part thereof in case it should be taken or lost by any prior or better claim - And that in case the said trustees should not cause the said building to be raised if covered as aforesaid, then and in that case the said five hundred acres of land is to be left back to my Children and to be equally divided

between them all It will be all lands that are not here devised more especially divided and disposed of to continue in the hands of my Executors for the payment of my said debts and the fulfillment of all my contracts And if necessary to be sold by my Execs for the education of my Children and the Support of my Family and after the death of my wife Elizabeth Hynes all lands that are not disposed of by my Execs for the purpose before mentioned to be equally divided between my Seven Children (to wit) Sarah Churchill, Elizabeth Harrison, Thomas Hynes, Nancy Hynes, Polly Hynes, Abner Hynes & Alfred Wm - son Hynes - Item I emancipate and set free my few negroes in the following manner (to wit) one Negro Boy name^d Bob which is now about fourteen years of age to be free at the age of thirty years, Also one other Negro boy named George about the age of seven years Old to be free at the age of thirty years - Also one other Negro boy named Rubin about seven years Old to be free at thirty years old - Also one negro Girl four years of age to be free at the age of twenty five years old and her offspring (if any) to be free at the age of twenty five years old forever - Also one Negro woman named Beck to be free at the death of my Master Hannah Barns - Item I do Ordain constitute and appoint my Stephen William R. Hynes Michael Campbell and my son Thomas Hynes (when he shall arrive at the age of twenty one

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years old) my sole Executors Jointly or severally
to make conveyances fulfill and defeat all previous
prior contracts that I may in any manner be
bound for and to do such other acts and things
touching the premises as they may find necessary
