Horse called B. old. Also the land whereon I now live contain-
ing one hundred and fifty acres Item I give and be-
queath unto my Daughter Elizabeth one Steep Yearling
called Gentle. Item I give and bequeath unto my

Daughter Polly one heifer Yearling better lady.
 Tom I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Nan-
 cy one Heifer Yearling called Betty. Tom I give
 and bequeath unto my wife Nanny all and sin-
 gular my whole Estate during her life after which
 to be equally divided between all my children. It
 is also my will and desire that the whole of the
 Property first above bequeathed should be the pro-
 perty of my wife during her life. And lastly I
 constitute, ordain and appoint my wife Nanny
