 and memory thanks be to God for the
 same and calling to mind the mortality
 of my body and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men ^{who gave it} once to die do make and ordain
 this my last will and testament First I
 commit My soul into the hands of
 almighty god ^{who gave it} and my body to the earth
 to be decently buried at the discretion of
 my executors herein after named and as
 touching such worldly estate as it hath
 pleased God to Bless me with on this life

I do devise, bequeath and dispose of the same
 in manner following, to wit, In the first
 place I will that all my Just debt, funeral
 expences &c shall be paid Secondly I give &
 bequeath to my beloved wife Anne Cramer
 One third part of the tract of land whereon
 I now live to her during her natural life
 and also give and bequeath to her my said
 wife, as aforesaid One Negro woman named
 Charlotte together with one third part of my
 personal estate to her and her heirs forever
 The residue of my estate both real & personal
 I give and bequeath to my five Children
 to wit, John, Peggy, Nancy, Kiziah and Squire
 in manner following to wit I give, will and
 desire to my two sons John and Squire the tract
 of tract land whereon I now live to them and
 their heirs forever still however subject to the
 incumbrance of this mother's one third part
 during her life as aforesaid provided nevertheless
 that in consideration of my two sons John &
 Squire having the land before mentioned ad-
 vanced to them in exclusion of their Sisters I
 will and desire that twenty pounds in Grads
 shall be paid out of the Estate before mentioned
 that is the part belonging to my two sons

John and Squire to their three Sisters Peggy, Nancy and Hesiah in a reasonable time after their said Sisters may marry or come of age that is to say twenty years in trade to each sister an equal proportion to be had from the estate of each of my son John and Squire I also give and bequeath unto my five Children John Peggy Nancy Hesiah and Squire the whole of my personal ^{estate} excepting the one third part bequeathed to their mother aforesaid to be equally divided amongst them It is also my will and desire that my negro boy Harry and Charlotte Child (with and her future increase if any) shall be kept on the premises for the support of my five Children before mentioned It is further my will and desire that my negro man named Rubin should be sold and his price divided amongst my five Children aforesaid provided nevertheless that it is my will & desire that in case my said wife Anne Cume should again marry that the two negroes Harry and Will as also Charlotte increase if any shall be held out from year to year and the profits of the hire
