 ordain Thomas Ashby for to be Justied with a Power to adjust
 in having all things ordered as they stand here stated and
 written without any alteration and I do renounce and refuse
 all other wills and forms and this only to be my last will and
 Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this thirtieth day of January in the
 fifteenth year of the Commonwealth In the year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one.
