In the Name of God Amen, I Gervin Hammond
 of Nelson County and State of Kentucky, make, pub-
 lish and declare this my last will and Testament in
 Manner and ^{form} following, (that is to say) I
 Give and bequeath to my wife Jane Hammond &
 for and during her natural life the tract or parcel
 of land wherein I now live, containing two hun-
 dred and fifty acres in lieu of her thirds of my lands
 agreeable to Law, also during the term of her natural
 life one third part of my slaves, I also will &
 bequeath her my said wife after payment is
 made of all my just and equitable debts, one
 third part of my personal property &
 I will and bequeath also to my her my said wife, the use
 and occupation of my stile until my son Thomas shall
 arrive at age of twenty one year, the better to maintain

her to school such of our children as are not ^{now} ~~now~~
 called. It is my will and desire, that my slaves, (my
 wife third excepted) be equally divided amongst
 my children or the surviving of them, within twelve months
 after my decease, and the land and slaves which may fall
 to my wife by virtue of this will, I will and bequeath
 in like manner to said children at her death
 and whereas I have a suit in Court against John
 Dogier, James Davis and James Dogier, it is my
 will and desire, that whatever may be recovered on
 said suit fall by equal Division amongst my
 children, It is my will and Desire that my executors
 make sale of the rest and residue of my property in
 twelve months after my ^{decease} ~~decease~~, and that when sold
 it may be on a credit of twelve months, and that the
 money arising from said sale fall equally amongst
 my children. I constitute and appoint my wife Jane
 Hammond and son Thomas Hammonds joint executor
 and executor of this my last will and Testament and I
 by annul all and every will and wills, heretofore made
 and executed by me, and declare this and this only
 to be my last and ~~only~~ will and Testament
 In Testimony whereof I have set my hand and
 affixed my seal this ^{15th} ~~15th~~ day of October in the
 Year of our Lord ~~one thousand eight hundred & 18~~ ¹⁸⁰⁶
