 and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament
 in the following manner & form —
 I Give & Bequeath unto my beloved
 wife Elizabeth Howard During her
 single life all the Plantation I now

Dwell on one Negro Woman named Ellen & one
 Negro young negro Child and all my moveable
 property after all my Just Debts is paid —

I Give and Bequeath unto my son Henry
 Howard the lower part of the land I now live
 on Beginning at a Sugar tree & bush standing
 in a hollow about 70 or 80 yards below the spring
 running a parcel line to the back line to him
 his heirs or assigns forever — — — —
 I Give & Bequeath unto my son George
 Howard the upper Part of my land where my
 Dwelling house now stands to him his
 heirs & assigns forever.

My Will is that my two sons ^{Henry} Howard and
 George Howard shall pay fifty Pounds to be
 Equally Divided among my Children viz^t
 Charles Howard William Howard Joseph
 Howard Mary Corby Sarah & Eliza
 Bray five years after the Death of the mother
 I Give unto my Daughter Mary Corby
 one Bed & furniture after her mother's Death —
 I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza
 Bray one Bed & furniture after her mother's Death

Will and Testament. First I Direct that
all my just debts be paid after which, I
Dispose of my Estate in the following Manner
I give and Bequeath to my beloved Wife
Sabanna Malin One Pair of Furniture, a
Spinning Wheel, my black Mare a Woman
Saddle, a Cow & Calf, a Plough, and Plough
Horn, with the necessary Gear, One Hoe and
Mattock, an Axe the Whet of the Chain, One Table
a Pot & large Iron Kettle, One Oven a Sheet, half
Dozen Plates, half Dozen Knives & Forks, One Chat
four Ewes & two Weathers half the hogging hog
in the fall, two sows & half the pigs & hogs,
my loom with the necessary Tackling. I give
and Bequeath to my Son Jacob Malin fifty
pounds, and to my Son John Malin & Zachariah
Malin Sixty pound each I also give to my
Grand son Jonathan the Sum of Sixty pounds
When we he shall settle himself I give &
bequeath to my Wife the use of the plantation
whereon I now reside during her life and at
her Death to be sold & the money Divided
Equally Between my six Sons & Grand son
I Appoint my Friend Edmund Polk,

Edmund Williams & My Son Jacob Malin Executors
of this my last Will & Testament, hereby Revoking
all former Wills by me made, declaring this only
to be my last Will & Testament,
Signed Sealed & Declared by the said Isaac Malin

on Monday the 9th day of May 1803

This last Will & Testament of Isaac Malin Senr
was proved by the Oaths of Ely Wright & Moses
Harrel two of the subscribing Witnesses thereto and
Sworn to by Edmund Polk Evan Williams and Jacob
Malin the Executors therein named and ordered to
be Recorded and on the motion of the said Executors the
Execution of the said Will is granted them they having
given bond with Moses Harrel & Ely Wright their
Securities in the penalty of three thousand Dollars
Conditioned as the Law Directs
