Fogles of the County of Nelson's State of Kentucky
being of sound mind memory and understanding do make
and constitute this my last Will and Testament in
manner and form following To wit: first I recommend
my soul to Almighty God that gave it & my body
to be decently buried at the discretion of my
Executor hereafter named first I Will and bequeath
to my son Robt. B. Fogles six Shillings then I will
and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Fogles the
sum of six Shillings then I will & bequeath to
my daughter Frances Fogles one Negro Girl Charity
and her 8 pendants, & her stock, half her mother's
wearing apparel and one Chest I also will and
bequeath to my daughter Sarah Fogles one Negro
boy Ben & one half of of her mother's wearing
apparel I also will and bequeath to my daughter
Ann three Negroes names Nick, Bob, & Wang
I will and bequeath to my two sons Joseph &
Christian Fogles all my lands to be equally

Divided between them but his known that my
other two sons are to have the Rest for the first
four years arising from S^d lands Namely my
son John & Fogler & William McShelvey Fogler
I also bequeath One Negro Man Name Ned to
my sons John & William Fogler & his heirs also
to be equally divided between them & also the
sum of _____ to be equally di-
vid between them I am also in addition to my
son Christian Fogler I will him one Negro Girl
named Rachel Also my will & desire is that
Jacob Beem J^r keep my Daughter Ann & her prop-
erty And also I will all the Rest of my Children
to John Hammet - whom I appoint the S^d Rem^t &
Hammet whole & sole Executor of this my last
Will and Testament hereby Revoking all former
Wills or Wills by me heretofore made In Testimony
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my Seal this 8th day of June A.D. 1808
hundred and four.
