Condition but of perfect mind and memory and Sug-
ment Thanks be to God for the same and calling to mind
the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed
out for man to die and being Desirous to settle
my affairs in line do make this my last will and
testament in manner and form following first after
my Just debts are paid and my body decently buried
I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth
Willitt my plantation with all my money and property
I own during her life as widowhood and also I do Give
to my young son George Willitt my plantation inow
live on after my wife's death if she marries then the
plantation to be let out to the best advantage at the
discretion of my Executors for the benefit of my son Sabo-
den in my wife to purchase five hundred Acres of Land
over the Ohio for my other five boys John Willitt Samuel
Willitt Griffith Willitt and Richard Willitt and to be
given to them as they come of age but if three of them
die with out issue their part to be divided amongst
the other boys all but George I also Give to my two young
daughters Elizabeth and Mary Willitt one hundred Dollars
apiece to be given to them as they come of age or get
married and at the death of my wife the rest of my

Estate to be Equally divided amongst ^{all} my children but if
any of them dies without issue their part to be divided
amongst the rest of my children I do also appoint my wife
Elizabeth Willitt and John Willitt my sole and sole Executors
to this my last will and testament In testimony hereof
I have unto set my hands and seal this first day of July
1811
