make and declare this my last Will and Testament
Firstly I will and direct that all my Just Debts be paid
Secondly I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Susan and one Negro Girl Named Aggy and
all her future increase to her and her heirs
forever and one Sore Cellare Saddle and Bridle
Thirdly I Give unto my son John Lightfoot one Negro

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Boy Named Jacob and one Brown Horse Saddle and Bridle
forever
Fourthly I Give unto my Daughter Nancy one Negro Girl Named
Mary and her ~~present~~ ^{future} increase to her and her heirs
forever one Bay filly Saddle & Bridle
Fifthly I Give unto my Daughter Polly one Negro Girl Named
Betsey and her ~~present~~ ^{future} increase to her and her heirs forever
and one Brown filly and Saddle & Bridle
Sixthly I Give unto my son Pendleton one Bay Mare called
Nannah and one Fourth part of my Stock of cattle
Hogs and Sheep and all the Furniture that I got by my
wife and all the property that I bought of the Estate of
Robert Slaughter Dec^d unto him forever and if my said
son Pendleton should die before he should come of age
then I will the said property to my Beloved wife Peggy
Lightfoot forever
Seventhly the Balance of my House hold furniture Stock of
Horse cattle Hogs Sheep ^{and} and apple Nurseries I will to be
sold by ^{my} ~~my~~ ^{and} ~~and~~ to pay my Debts
Eightly I Give unto my two sons Philip & Robert Jointly
Four Negroes Namely Lind, Sally, Daphny, and another
to be Equally Divided between them forever and if
there should be a Surplus of money arising from the
Sale of my house hold furniture not heretofore dis-
posed of and of my Stock of horses cattle Hogs
Sheep crops and Nurseries after paying my Debts
I then give that Surplus unto my said sons Philip
& Robert to them and their heirs forever
My Daughters Betty Waller and Amelia Gentry I
have long since given all that I intended for them
I ~~have~~ ^{leave} my sons John and Philip together with my friend
James Slaughter Sen^r of this County my Cons to this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking all
former one by me made in testimony whereof
I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seals
