of Nelson County and State of Kentucky being sworn
body but of sound disposing mind and memory and

Calling to mind the certainty of Death and the uncertainty of the time when, do for the disposing of my worldly Goods and affairs make and Ordain This my last will and Testament as followeth to wit, It is my Desire that my body be decently Interred and my last Debts and Funeral Charges paid by my Executor, and Executors Hereafter Mentioned—

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Rebecca Beall all that tract of land I Bought of Joshua Brown wherein Aaron Harris now lives all my Cotts. of ground and Improvements, thereon lying in Barbers Town also all my slaves I now possess (to wit) John, Frank, Yake, Matt, Bird, Harry, now at Bourbon Turnace—also Rindle, Major, Ben, Daniel, Dary, and Dinah, also Amey and Rachel and their Increase, and all my Stock of Horses Cattle and Hogs, as also all my household Furniture and plantations utensils. I may possess at my Death for her use and Service During her natural life and after her Death I Give the whole of the same properly to my son Samuel Beall his heirs and assigns forever, but Should he dye without heir or heirs lawfully begotten by his body, before he come to the age of Twenty one years then and in such case the whole of what I have given him It is my Desire shall be Equally Divided between all my Grand Children by my son Walter and the Children of my Daughter Susanna that is now and may hereafter be born lawfully begotten to be Equally Divided between them share and share alike—

Item I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Walter Beall five Shillings current money of Kentucky for his part of my Estate to him and his heirs forever—

Item I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Susanna Thomas wife of Edward S Thomas five Shillings current Money of Kentucky for her part of my Estate and it is my will and Desire that the Negro I have a bill of Sale for from Edward S Thomas (to wit) Tall, Frank, Amey, Mully, Charity, Lillab, Sandy, Seno, Bill, and Harriell and their Increase shall be Equally Divided between Fanny Thomas, Walter Thomas, and Malinda Thomas heirs of Susanna

Thomas Wife of Edward S Thomas and all the heirs of her Body. Hereafter Should have any, and the said Negroes and their Increase to be Equally Divided between those Children and all those my Daughter Susanna may have hereafter shall share Equally with those now in being but said Negroes to Remain in possession of their Mother Susanna Thomas and in her Service During her Natural life if she require it to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Also I leave unto my Daughter Susanna Thomas Children as aforesaid to be Equally Divided Between the whole of what she have now and what she may have hereafter two twelve hundred acre tracts of land in the bounds of the Indians lands it is also my Desire that my Executor and Executors Should at the Expense of my Estate lease the said two Tracts of land in the boundaries of the Indians lands twelve hundred acres Each. So as there may be a power for the same which will be on Emigee purchasing lands of the Indians which will Include this land to them their heirs and Assigns forever—

Item I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Grand Son Walter Beall Son of my son Walter Two Hundred and forty acres of land on the west fork of Coxs Creek it being one half of a tract of land four hundred and Eighty Acres Entered in the name of David Grauford to him and his heirs and assigns forever—

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Beloved Son Samuel Beall all the Residue of my Estate both real and Personal to him and his heirs and assigns forever but Should he dye before he come to the age of twenty one years without heir or heirs lawfully begotten by his body, in such case Should he have heir or heirs before he come of age as aforesaid they are to have the whole of what I have before given him, and be it further understood that Should he my son Samuel live to come to the age of twenty one years then and in such case it is my Desire he Should freely possess the whole of what I have before given him and Dispose of it by will or otherwise as he may think Proper And lastly I do hereby appoint and constitute My Beloved wife Rebecca Beall my Executor and Nathaniel Harrison Charles Darcy Senr. & Walter Harris Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking

and making void all other wills and Testaments whatever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this day of one Thousand Eight hundred and two.
