do make and ordain this my last will and testament writing and
recommending all others hereto for by me made. I first recommend
my soul to almighty god who gave it. trusting in the merits of my
redemption to receive forgiveness of all my sins, and what worldly goods
the Lord has been please to bestow on me after my just debts is
paid and funeral expenses. I give and bequeath in the following manner
Item 1. I give unto my son John Dran one Gray horse sold now one year
old for the use of his son Thomas Dran.

Item 2. I then give unto my son Richards Dran all the rest of my
Estate Consisting of house hold furniture houses cattle hogs with
all my personal effects and I do appoint and ordain my son
Richard Dran my full and sole Executor to this my last will and
testament. Given under my hand and signed by me this 7
may in the year of our Lord 1810. in the presence of
