The above last will and testament of Barnaby Nally deceased was proved by the oaths of Henry Beach and Enock Hagan subscribing witnesses and ordered to be recorded

Nelson County Septembers County court 1814 Ordered that Andrew Boyle Humphrey, May Thomas Wofford and Robert Anderson carry three of them being just men before a magistrate of this County to appraise in current money the slaves, furs and personal estate of Edmund Stallard deceased and return thereat pursuant to court

This day came before me a Justice of the peace for the County aforesaid, Andrew Boyle Humphrey, May & Robert Anderson and qualified to the within intent Give-during my hand this 10 day of Oct. 1814
