 and friends again do constitute and appoint this my last will
 and testament hereby revoking all former wills and testament
 heretofore made by me First I will and bequeath the all my just
 debts to be paid by my executors her after appointed of them
 I give and bequeath all my property to the widow and person or
 persons my wife Ann Cosby during her natural life provided
 that said Ann Cosby is not to receive the property left in
 her care and for her support and the support of my children
 I leave all my property after my wife's death to be divided
 among my executors to be used by them for the nurture
 and ^{education} of my children and so much of my estate as can be paid over
 and above the necessary support of my wife and children to be
 appropriated to the education of my children I leave my said
 wife should manage my estate as she shall see fit her share of my
 estate and the balance of my estate to be applied to the edu-
 cation and nurture of my children I leave the whole ^{management}
 of my estate is to be under the immediate ^{direction}
 directions of John Cosby and Richard Cook who I appoint
 my executors
