 April 1812 I Daniel Casaday of Nicholas
 County & State of Kentucky being Sick and
 weak in body all the of sound mind and Memory that
 be to God, Wherefore and Calling to mind the mor-
 tality of my Body and that it is appointed for all
 men once to die do make ~~this~~ and ordain this my
 last Will and Testament that is to say principally
 and first of all Give & Recommend my Soul
 in to the hands of almighty God who gave it and
 my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be decently
 Buried in Decent Christian burial at the discre-
 tion of Executors nothing doubting but at the gene-
 ral Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of God and as touching such Worldly
 Estate where with it has pleased God to bless me in this
 life I Give Dispose and Dispose of the same in the

The following manner & form; I Give & bequeath
 to my son Thomas Casaday and my son Jeremiah
 the plantation I now live on by their giving
 my Daughter Sally reasonable Support of
 the Plantation so long as she lives unmarried &
 to my son William one hundred Dollars to be
 paid in property one year after my Decese also
 to my son Thomas one hundred Dollars two year
 after my Decese to be paid in property I also
 bequeath to my Daughter Sally the Bee that
 she now claims and one Cow her Choice out of my
 flock I will and Bequeath to my grand Daugh-
 ter Nancy one Red muldy Cow while she lives
 she now claims then all the ballance of my person-
 al property to be sold to publick sale and the
 money arising there from to be Equally Divided
 amongst my Heirs, and I also will & Bequeath
 to my Daughter Mary Fifty Dollars to be
 paid in property five years after my Decese
 to be paid by my two sons Thomas & Jeremiah
 Whereas I have make constitute and ordain the
 sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament
 (Wit) James & Jeremiah Casaday my two sons
 I do hereby Disallow Revoke and Disannul all and
 Every other wills Legacies & Executors by me in
 any way before named ~~and~~ will and bequeath
 Writing & Confirming this & no other to be my last
 Will and Testament, In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand Seal, this day & Date above
 Written Signed Sealed published and Delivered by
 the said Daniel Casaday as his last Will and Testa-
 ment in the presence of us who in his presence
 and in the presence of each other have

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In the name of God Amen I Matthew Deal ~~Deceased~~ of the County of Nicholas and State of Kentucky being weak in ~~body~~ but of sound mind and memory (Blessed be to God) Dath this Fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred & Thirteen I make this my last Will & Testament in the following manner. That is to say I do allow all my Just Debts to be paid I do pay & I do Bequeath to my Beloved Wife Phoebe all my Household Furniture and one Horse called Dick also one Cow also to live on my Land During her being a widow also I give to her my Wife one Negro woman named Dinah while she remains a Widow; I Bequeath to my son Isaac two Negro Boys named Elijah & Frank and at his Mothers Marriage or Death he is to have the Negro woman called Dinah if a live & also I do Bequeath him my ~~Land~~ Isaac my Bay & Brown Horses one Cow and Heifer & one Steer and my said son Isaac is to School the rest of my Children so far as to Read and Write & to see them put to Trades

I also Bequeath to my son James one Negro Boy named Andy & also one young horse rising three years

Fourthly I do Bequeath to each of my younger Sons two Dollars to each of them that is to say to Matthew William John Purnell & Joshua and do make my said Isaac & ordain in my sole Execution of this my Will intrest for the Intent & purposes in this my Will Contained and
