buried at the discretion of my friends: and in  
my worldly goods and chattels I do bequeath in  
the following manner: first to my Wife Mary  
Burdick One third of my personal Estate during  
her Widowhood. This to be equally divided  
between my sons whom I have had by my late  
Wife: Do my son Elijah Burdick One hundred  
Dollars to be raised out of the remaining two  
thirds: Do my son Charles Burdick One Dollar  
likewise to my several Daughters one Dollar  
each to be paid in the same manner: the balance  
to be equally divided between my other sons whom  
I have had by my late Wife: William B. who  
of Bourbon County I do appoint my Executor.
