McManully of the State of Kentucky
County of Nicholas being in a Sound State
of Body & Health. But of Sound mind
and memory have this day made and
ordained this my Last Will and Testament
in the manner following viz —
It is my will and desire that my Just
Debt and funeral Expenses be Paid out
of my Personal Estate as soon as can be
conveniently done by Executors —
It is my will that my beloved Brother
James McManully shall have forty acres of
my Land to be laid off adjoining Allen
Line in such a manner as to include the
improvement where he now Lives and to
so as to do the Least injury to the Remain-
ing Part of my Land to him and his heirs
forever — It is my will that my
beloved Brother Joseph McManully have
the remaining sixty acres of my Land
with all that Part of my fathers real
Estate which may fall to my share to
him and his heirs forever, and in case the
said Joseph should die before he is 21 years
of age the profits arising from my the
aforesaid Part of my fathers real Estate
till he would be twenty one years of age
must be equally divided amongst all my
Brothers and Sisters, which during the Life
of the said Joseph must be applied for his
Education —

326 It is my will that my Sister (to wit) Sally
Jane Eliza and Rachel or such of them
as shall remain unmarried till the said
aforesaid Joseph is twenty one years of age
shall have all the profits arising from
the aforesaid sixty acres of Land to their use
and behoof and should my brother Joseph
McManully die before he is twenty one
years of age being unmarried the aforesaid
Land must be equally divided amongst the
aforesaid Sally Jane Eliza and Rachel
McManully to them and their heirs forever and
also all that Part of my Personal Estate
Property remaining after my debts are
Paid to be divided in like manner amongst
them — And I do here by constitute
and appoint Alexander Blair Guardian
for my Brother Joseph in what respects
the Part designated to him of my estate &
further that the said Alexander Blair
and Hugh Cowan are here by constituted
Executors of this my Last Will and Tes-
tament which I hereby declare to be my
Last Will and Testament by me this 5th
day of May anno Domini 1815 —

An Instrument of Writing purporting
to be the Last Will and Testament of
John Manumet, Deceased, was produced in
open Court and proven by the
Oath of Hugh Wiley and sworn to before
and at the August County Court 1815 it was
proven by the Oath of John Hill a Sub-
scribing Witness thereto and ordered to be
Recorded - and on Motion of A. Blair
Blair and Hugh Cowan the Executors
therein named who made Oath thereto and
together and entered into Bond in the
Penalty of \$300 Current Money of Kentu-
ky with Hugh Wiley and James
Thomson, their Securities, Conditioned ac-
cording to Law, which is ordered to be Record-
ed and thereupon Certificate is granted
them for obtaining a Probate thereof
