 after my Decease to be paid in property I also
 bequeath to my Daughter Selley the Bee that
 she now claims and one Cow her Choice out of my
 flock I will and Bequeath to my grand Daugh-
 ter Nancy one Red muly Cow while for the
 she now claims then all the ballance of my person-
 al property is to be sold to publick sale and the
 money arising there from to be Equally Divided
 amongst my Heirs, and I also Will & Bequeath
 to my Daughter Mary Fifty Dollars to be
 paid in property five years after my Decease
 to be paid by my two sons Thomas & Jeromiah,
 Whereas likewise make Constitue and Ordain the
 sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament
 (viz) James & Jeromiah Casaday my two sons
 I do hereby Disallow Revoke and Disannul all and
 Every other my Wills Legacies & Executors by me in
 any way before named said Will and bequeath
 Writing & Confirming this & no other to be my last
 Will and Testament, In witness whereof I have
