In the name of God Amen: this fifteenth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seven: W^m Allen Sen^r of the County of Nicholas and State of Kentucky, being in a low state of health, but of sound mind and memory, do hereby be God for this future, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the form and manner following: first that it is my Will that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid out of my estate: - second that all my property be duly inventoried and kept for the use of my family: - third that the land which I have contracted for with Capt. John Fowler to be paid for out of the stock & property now in my possession: - fourth that my beloved Wife Margaret Allen shall be maintained off the land and have the use of my property in the same manner as in my lifetime and that my children which now live with me shall come to the age of 21 years each shall have a proportionable part of the personal property then in hand, so as not to deprive the family of a sufficiency to support them comfortably of which my Executors and my honest Neighbors who is acquainted with the family shall be the judges: - Fifth that all that which I own the land shall be divided equally

between my sons John, James & Samuel or if any of them should die before that time without issue then to those of them which may survive and that all my personal property which may then remain in hand which may not be subject to the above named division shall be equally divided amongst my children that now live with me viz. Eleanor, John, Sally, James, Peggy, Jane and Samuel: or to those of them which may then be deceased that Dorothy Hill, William Allen and Anne Ireland shall have one and possess the portion which each of them have received of me to them and their heirs free from any division or any incumbrance or any account: - Seventh that my family or my Executors shall not be responsible for the loss of the inevitable loss of any part of my personal property: - Eighth I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons John Hill and John Allen Executors of this my last Will and Testament: hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.
