In the name of God, amen I Samuel Evansford of the County of Nicholas being very sick and weak of body and of perfect mind and memory thanks to God unto God calling to mind the shortness of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men one to die do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament: that is to say, principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that give it: and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the direction of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God - And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form: first of all my just debts to be paid: next I give and bequeath to Mary my Wife: whom I likewise constitute make and Ordain the sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. all my real and personal estate except one Dollar to my son Moses. Next I bequeath to my Daughter Mary one Dollar next to my son John I bequeath one Dollar next to my son Samuel I bequeath one Whiffpoan and one Croquet ~~and~~ and all my other bartering tools: Next I bequeath to my son William one Bay mare two years old paid of the name of fly. Next to my Daughter Abigail I bequeath one Dollar: And I do hereby revoke revoke and disannul all and every other former Will legacies bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named. Will and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to ^{be my} last.
