it is appointed once for all men to die, do constitute and
ordain this my last will and Testament in the manner
and form following, to wit
First of all I leave my soul to God who gave it and my
body to the ants from whence it came to be Buried
at the Discretion of my wife and children, and for
all my just debt to be paid out of my personal Estate
Then I leave to my well beloved wife all that part of my
Estate contained in the Articles of agreement between
myself and Eliza Barlow, during her lifetime and then
for it to go to the said Eliza Barlow
Then Give to my well beloved Son William Barlow
and Daughter, Elizabeth, Hannah and Hannah
Mary Epifon Easton Fing and Lemmy Sadler the
Money arising from the sale of a certain tract of Land
containing forty acres now sold to my son William
Barlow and from the sale of two Horse Carriages
one a road mare and the other a Black mare except
so much as will leave one Dollar to my son John Barlow
and one Dollar to my son Franky Barlow and one
Dollar to my son Jesse Barlow and one Dollar to
my daughter Emily Barlow which I give and bequeath
to each of them - And I do hereby appoint William
Barlow and Jesse Baskett Executors to this my last
will and Testament in writing whereof I have subscribed
set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day
of September in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
and Eight
