I David Lowrey of the County of Nicholas and State of Kentucky
being weak of body, but of sound mind, and knowing that it is appoint-
ment to mankind once to die, and wishing to set my house in order
do hereby the following lines as my last Will and Testament.

Item first. I do hereby recommend to God who gave it, and my body to it,
mother Earth, to be buried in a decent Christian form.

After all my just debts and funeral expenses is paid, I will and
bequeath to my beloved wife Letitia Lowrey one third of all my
estate both real and personal during her natural life, to be
disposed of by her for the use of the family in supporting herself and
them.

Item second. The balance of my estate I leave to my two daughters
Jane & Mary Lowrey and my grand daughter, Pansy C. Hobbs,
in the manner following Jane & Mary is to have an equal share
of all my realty and land and money, and my grand daughter Pansy
C. Hobbs, to have her equal share of the land after reduction out
the money that is in my hands as Administrator of the estate of
her father, Milton Hobbs, no part of the land to be sold, but the property
and land for their support, and the money to be for their support
also.

Also it is my wish for my wife Letitia Lowrey to be my executrix
of this my last Will and Testament, so long as she remains un-
married without disability. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 2d day of November 1834.
