of this County and Commonwealth of Kentucky
being weak of Body but of sound and disposing
Mind and memory calling to mind the uncertainty
of this Life and that it is appointed that all men
must die do make and constitute this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following
I Commit my body to the Earth from whence
it came and my soul into the Hand or Protection
of Almighty God who formed and created it And
as to all my worldly Estate with which it hath
pleased God to bless me - I Give and bequeath it
in manner and form following (To wit)
Impremise, I Give and bequeath unto my wife
Frances the plantation whereon I now live containing
two hundred acres or upwards with all its appurtenances
to have and to hold for herself and heirs forever -
Item I Give and bequeath to each of my Daughters
 Polly White wife of Joseph White and Sarah Stevenson
 wife of John Stevenson one Dollar each -
Item I Give and bequeath all my stock of Horn
Cattle Hogs farming utensils House hold Furniture
 and all personal property belonging to me to my wife
 Frances after all my last debts are paid to be
 her own forever

And I do hereby Nominate and appoint
 My Wife Frances my Executrix to this my
 last Will and Testament to attend to the Execution
 of the same in manner and form aforesaid
 hereby revoking all former wills by me made &

declaring this to be my last Will and Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this third day of July 1818
 Hundred and Seventeen

Ohio County Court 1st November 9th 1818
 This last will and Testament of John Anderson
 died was Exhibited in Court & proved by the
 oath of James Houston a subscribing

 on the 10th day of May 1819 the said will
 was fully proved by the oath of Richard W
 Barrett another subscribing Witness thereto
 & ordered to be recorded
