In the name of God et men, I John Miller of Ohio County and State of Kentucky being sick and weak in body but sound of mind and memory and reflecting that that it is appointed for all men one to die do make Constitute and ordain this to be my last will and testament (that is) that my just debts shall all be paid and the remainder of my Estate of every description I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ruth Miller for and during her natural life of widowhood and after her death or marriage whatever then remains or is in being except when the law may otherwise direct my desire is that it should be equally divided amongst all my Children in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th day of October 1816
