In the name of God

I Joseph Barnes of this County and State of Kentucky being at this time in health and of sound and disposing mind and memory Revoking all other wills by me made Do ordain, make and constitute this my last will and Testament This 15th day of May 1821 Do first of all direct my legal Executors hereafter named to dispose of my property in the following manner hereafter mentioned, I give and bequeath to my Loving wife Mary Barnes and third part of my Estate during her life and then to be Equally divided amongst my Children Joshua Barnes, John Barnes, Hiram Barnes, Charlotte Hender, Haney Fork and Eleanor Washington I do will and order that at the of my say and Loving wife Mary Barnes that my two Black men and women (to wit) Saed Adam and Henrietta be and shall be free from bondage and that they enjoy their liberty as free Coloured people of this State and and further I will that should Henrietta have any Children hereafter that they be free in the following manner the males at thirty five years old and females at thirty two years old and that my Black Girls and Children be free in the following manner from and after this date Harriet to serve eleven years and then to be free and should she have any Children hereafter to be free in like manner with those of Henrietta and Abby to serve thirteen years and then to be free and be issue if any to be in like manner with Harriet, Mahala to serve seventeen years and then to be
