I Joseph Barnes of this County and State of Kentucky being at this time in health and of sound and disposing mind and memory Revoking all other wills by me made Do ordain, make and constitute this my last will and Testament This 15th day of May 1821 Do first of all direct my legal Executors hereafter named to dispose of my property in the following manner hereafter mentioned, I give and bequeath to my Loving wife Mary Barnes and third part of my Estate during her life and then to be Equally divided amongst my Children Joshua Barnes, John Barnes, Hiram Barnes, Charlotte Hender, Haney Fork and Eleanor Washington I do will and order that at the of my say and Loving wife Mary Barnes that my two Black men and women (to wit) Saed Adam and Henrietta be and shall be free from bondage and that they enjoy their liberty as free Coloured people of this state and and further I will that should Henrietta have any Children hereafter that they be free in the following manner the males at thirty five years old and females at thirty two years old and that my Black Girls and children be free in the following manner from and after this date Harriet to serve eleven years and then to be free and should she have any Children hereafter to be free in like manner with those of Henrietta and Abby to serve thirteen years and then to be free and be issue if any to be in like manner with Harriet, Mahala to serve seventeen years and then to be

free and her Issue if any to be free in like manner as Mary Maurenda to serve twenty one years and then to be free and her Issue if any to be free in like manner as Mahalas, and that Lydia serve twenty one years and then to be free and her Issue if any to be free in like manner as Maurenda Mary to serve twenty six years and then to be free and her Issue if any to be free in like manner with Lydia Manary to serve thirty one years and six months and then to be free and her Issue if any to be free in like manner with Mary Daniel to serve seven and after this Date one year and then to be free Joseph to serve thirty three years from this date and then to be free Henry to serve thirty four years and seven months from this date then to be free - I give and bequeath to my Son in Law William Leach five Dollars as I gave him his legacy previous to this date I give and bequeath to my son Weaver Barnes the tract of Land I now live on to him and his heirs forever and I do further will and direct that all my Estate that I may leave at my death shall be Equally Divided amongst my Children Joshua Barnes John Barnes Weaver Barnes and sons in Law Robert Renda Thomas Worthington and Agriah Fick and I do further Give and bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Fick one hundred dollars over and above her Equal Dividend to her and her heirs forever as I have gave nothing heretofore - I do further Give and bequeath

to my Grand son Joseph Barnes son of Joshua Barnes my Nephew by Garret at my death which is to serve him and his heirs twenty eight years from this date then to be free and also a house to be worth fifty Dollars. I do hereby appoint Joshua Barnes John Barnes and Robert Renda my sons in law my Executors.
