

In the name of God Amen I Philip Hocker of this County and State of Kentucky do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the following manner & form to wit

First I give And bequeath to my Negro man Harry his freedom to Commence immediately after my decease I also give And bequeath to my Negro Woman Viney her freedom to Commence immediately after my decease and provided she should have any Children at that time I will that all of them either and or more shall have their freedom at the age of Twenty five years

I then I give and bequeath to my sons Nicholas, Richard Weaver and Philip and to my Daughters Delilah Dorcas, Polly and the heirs of my Daughter Betsey the sum of five Shillings Each. I then I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Davis all the Rest of my property that I may be possessed of at my Death for her use and the use of her heirs for their use and that only said property not to be subject to Execution for the payment of any prior debts or to be taken from the said Sarah or her heirs without their own and free Consent

And I also appoint Robert Henderson Junr my whole and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills and Testaments by me made Witness my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and twenty

At a County Court holden for this County in the State of Kentucky at the Courthouse in Harpord on the 13th day of August 1821. This last will and Testament of Philip Hocker deceased was proved by the oaths of William Phipps and Lodowick Davis Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and thereupon Robert Henderson the Executor named in the said will now in Court refused to take upon himself the Execution of the said will and thereupon on motion of Benjamin Grays who took the Oath prescribed by Law and with Alexander McHardy his Security Executed Bond in the penalty of \$1000 conditioned as the law directs a certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration of the Estate of the said Philip Hocker decd. with the will annexed in due form
