which after deducting \$600 and 39 cents for his third part or share leaves \$1216 and 59 cents to which we add \$100 for the hire of a negro man for four years makes to the \$117 and 39 cents balance on money due \$1733 and 89 cents we then deduct from the amount \$733 and 33 cents for the value of the two negroes which falls to the heirs which leaves \$1000 and 56 cents to which we add the balance of the \$1000 hire makes \$1036 and 56 cents to be divided equally between second Legatee which makes each one part \$518-28-06 Given under our hands this 10th day of Dec 1824
