

In obedience to an order of this Worship the Justices of the peace for this County the undersigned commissioners appeared being first duly sworn and placed on the twenty eighth day of July 1827 to lay off and allot Elizabeth Smith Widow Heiress of Thomas Smith dec'd her Rights Claim to Thomas Seymour whose total value was then Thomas and Henry find Dollars when the following allotment was made to wit

One negro Woman named Ann	Value	\$175
One negro Woman " Mary "	"	325
One negro Child named Molly "	"	100
One negro Man named George "	"	400

Finding the above to be as nearly as we could arrange them an Equal allotment have set them apart for said P'd and Quors under and under this 29th day of July 1827

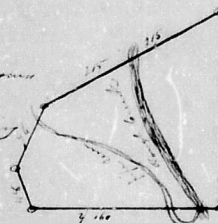

Agreeable to an order of Bonomales

Court as above named in the undersigned commission as appeared by the above named Court at their Session held in the year 1820 under a warrant to that end laid off and allotted or apportioned to George Shreader or Widow of George Shreader dec'd as a certain parcel of land conveyed from



to George Shreader to said George Shreader as appears upon record in the Clerk's office of the Court containing seven hundred and thirty four and half acres out of which we have laid off 192 acres as the proper share of the above named widow the boundaries of which are as follows: Begin rising at the Confluence of Pipe Run with Rough Creek in the lower line of the above named & 734 rods bearing where it crosses Rough Creek thence with the same west 190 poles to a Black Oak bush near said road thence S 20° W 48 poles to a white oak thence S 25° E 76 poles to a white oak thence S 62° E 210 poles to a marked bush thence south to a large bush on the aforementioned land thence south the same to the Beginning which parcel of Land we hereby allot to the said Widow of Shreader as her lawful right of dower under and under this 4th day of December 1830
