one two years old bay filly fourthly I will

one two years old bay filly which fillies
they are to have at my death fifthly I
will and bequeath to my two daughters
Julia Fulkerson and Susan Fulkerson
one feather bed and bedstead and furniture
a piece sixthly I will that my Oliver P
Fulkerson have nine months schooling at the
