Article first - In order to the payment
of all my just debts I would require
first the sale of the following property
in the Order they are mentioned here-
in - my bay Coll, and my Sadd &c.,
my two old mares all of my stock
of hogs except what will be necessary
for a years provision for my family
all my cattle except two Cows and
my old Yoke of Steers all of my
Crop of Corn except what will
keep my family for the present year
all of my family utensils after my
wife has her legal allotment all
of my present Crop of tobacco.

my Sugar Cured and all the appurtenances
Article Second - I wish my Contract to
Andrew Baker to furnish him 8000 Staves
to be fulfilled by my executor -

Article Third - Provided that the above
mentioned property when sold is in-
sufficient to pay all of my just
debts I further empower my executor
to sell my lands or enough of it
to satisfy all legal claims against
me

Article Fourth - To my beloved wife
Hannah Pickerson after the payment
of debts, I will and bequeath all of
my lands to her to have and to
hold during her natural life for

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her use and benefit, and when she dies it is to be sold and the proceeds to be equally divided among all of my children to wit: Margaret Elizabeth, Eliza Jane, William Thomas John G. James G. Septimus P. Minnie M. Charles M. & Sarah L. Pickerson. But I do should there be anything left after the payment of my debts from the sale of my personal property I wish it to be given to my beloved wife Hannah Pickerson. And I do should the personal property before mentioned fall short of enough to pay my debts I then wish all of my perishable property disposed of before my land only leaving to my wife what the law allows her.

Article 4th I now nominate and appoint Richard A. Jones of Mulheberg County my personal representative with full powers and constitute him my sole Executor - All of the above I have in the presence of these witnesses acknowledge to be my act and deed this January 18th 1860
