hereby direct authorize and empower my
said Executor to sell and dispose of all of my
property of every kind or description in such
manner as he in his discretion and judgment
may deem most advantageous to my heirs

And I hereby authorize and empower my
Executor to sell and convey my tract of land
that I now occupy and live on if in his
judgment or opinion it will be more con-
ducive to the interest of my heirs to sell it than
for them to retain it and of this I desire
him to be the Judge and act and do in the
premises as he thinks best and it is my
further will that after the payment of my
debts the net and residue of my Estate dis-
posed to and be divided among my heirs equally
under the laws of the State I do here by
nominate and appoint my Father-in-Law
Joseph Miller my sole Executor of this will
and request of him to act as such and carry
into effect its provisions as his judgment
and discretion may direct and do withal
my property as he may think proper

1st I desire all my Just debts paid and when that is done I will and bequeath unto my son Samuel O' Bishop one hundred acres of land say the land on which I now live which land the above named Samuel O' Bishop is to have and to hold as his own lawful property at my death and I do will & bequeath unto my son Samuel O' Bishop three head of horse & creatures now in my possession also 6 head Cattle it being all the Cattle and horses owned by me and in my possession and all my sheep and all my stock of Hogs more or less and all farming utensils with all the house hold & kitchen furniture which property the above named Samuel O' Bishop is to have & to hold as his own rightfull property for ever in consideration of and for the above bequeath the above named Samuel O' Bishop is bound to take care of and to sustain both myself Erasmus Bishop his father and Anne Bishop his mother and

wife of Erasmus Bishop during our natural lives which care and support is to be a reasonable and comfortable support and I also will and bequeath unto Samuel O' Bishop a certain head of cattle the price not being included in the above part of this my will and testament and I do will and bequeath unto my daughter Anne M'Hard one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son John O' Bishop one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth O' Bird one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son Thompson O' Bishop one dollar I do will and bequeath unto my son William O' Bishop one dollar and also unto my son Samuel O' Bishop my executor to this my last will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of December in the year of our Lord 1848
