

At a County Court held for this County on 2nd day of September 1839 the nuncupate will of Abida P Burks was produced in Court and from Richard Burks a Subscribing witness thereto and again at a County Court held for this County on the 4th day of October 1839 the said will was produced by David B Gordon another Subscribing witness and ordered to be recorded and again at a County Court held for said County on the 24 day of March 1840 on motion of David B Gordon who took the oath required by law and with David B Burks his security entered into bond in the penalty of \$500 Conditioned as the law directs a Certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration with the nuncupative will annexed of Abida P Burks deed in due form

Coming to the affliction that I now lie hereunder and this is my last will and testament I first will my soul to god and my body to be decently buried and the expenses paid out of my present crop off to habbo and William Ashby to be my executors to settle all my business and all that is left to go to my wife Rebecca so in during her widowhood and at her death or ~~before~~ had marriage to belong to my five children and the money in Virginia to be got and enough of it allowed to secure a piece of land to raise my children and the deed to my wife Rebecca during her widowhood and then to belong to my five children
